CELEBRITY CRUISES Highest guest-to-staff ratio in the premium category means you're pampered with spas, boutiques, nightclubs, and sorbet served by poolside butlers. On new *Solstice*, *Equinox*, and *Eclipse* (April 2010), sample vodkas at the martini bar. **Set sail:** *Solstice* offers seven-day itineraries from Ft. Lauderdale to St. Kitts, San Juan, St. Maarten, St. Thomas, Grand Cayman, or Tortola. From \$799/person; celebritycruises.com

CUNARD Sail the seas in refined English style. On the *Queen Mary 2*, enjoy the spa, a planetarium, ballroom dancing, and afternoon tea; *Queen Victoria* offers many of these perks. A new *Queen Elizabeth*, with 1930s Art Deco style, will launch October 2010. **Set sail:** Visit the Canary Islands, Madeira, Portugal, and Spain on an 11-day *QV Iberian Adventure*, May 3, 2010, from Southampton, England. HOLLAND AMERICA Wide teak decks, maritime artifacts, tennis, cooking classes, sizable staterooms, a library/coffeehouse, and comedy shows. *Eurodam* has a pan-Asian restaurant and gorgeous pool areas with private cabanas. **Set sail:** Try a seven-day sailing on *Eurodam* from Ft. Lauderdale to Turks & Caicos, San Juan, St. Thomas, and Holland America's private island, Half Moon Cay. From \$699/person; hollandamerica.com

NORWEGIAN CRUISE LINE The freedom of a resort and the attitude of a boutique hotel. Enjoy bowling alleys, gyms, sports bars, and comedy from Second City. *Epic*, launching June 2010, will include a squash court, rappelling wall, and water park, plus 20 restaurants (the most at sea) and 60 suites with private sundeck and pool. **Set sail:** *Pride of America* sails year-round seven-day Hawaiian cruises. PRINCESS CRUISES Intimate feel despite thousands on board. Watch movies from poolside loungers; enroll in art classes; and stroll bistros, shops, and wine bars. The adults-only pool offers a shaded retreat, headphones with fun playlists, and fresh smoothies. **Set sail:** Book a seven-day "Classic" itinerary on *Caribbean Princess* from San Juan to Tortola, Barbados, Antigua, St. Lucia, and St. Thomas.
